COMMENTARY

Barrenness is something attributed to those persons or other biological beings that cannot reproduce, well due to bad function of their organs or that their gametes are defective. The causes of sterility are diverse and vary between man and woman. There are also barren persons in affective feelings, in generosity, in biblical reasoning, that for as much as they learn, the same remain as the fig tree in the parable where there is no fertilizer, no rain, no water that will make them give fruit. Only the eternal fire has power over them.
