## COMMENTARY

---

Actually there is a world population of about 6,602,000,000 (Six billion six hundred two million) of inhabitants. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), 59 million deaths are recorded annually and in the surveys the predominant death is mental (alcoholism, drug use, depression, lack of mental health, etc). 1/4 of the planet suffers it. In second place it is the cardiovascular disease, in third place cancer, in fourth place AIDS, fifth place tuberculosis, and lastly, diabetes and others.

What is true is that there is a plague of illnesses and a primary illness that exists in the world is sin (Romans 3:23).

Let us remember that illness is change of health, a process of bodily decay, and to not be sick frequently, the Eternal commands us to follow his word, and upon nearing Christ he gives us the privilege of healing (Isaiah 53:4-5) according to his will.
