COMMENTARY

The word chastity comes from the greek root "agnos", which means clean, modest, pure, chaste, thus a married person is chaste due to being faithful to the spouse. On the other hand, a person upon contaminating their body, for example, with unclean meat, is not chaste anymore.

Because not only being unfaithful to the spouse is a person not chaste, but due to enjoying the delights of the flesh, or rather giving the body all that it asks us for, because chastity is also synonym of continence and abstinence of the delights of the flesh. May God will that we understand what we owe obedience to the Creator and to keep ourselves in chastity in obedience to his commandments.
