## COMMENTARY

---

We should be careful of not believing, not lending our ear to false doctrines and to not contaminate ourselves with commandments of man; in our hearts only the Eternal must live; in our hearts there should be no doubt of what we have received, let us not allow in our hearts bitterness to take root that may take us apart from the love of God.

Let us analyze that young man that asked the Master "...what shall I do to obtain eternal life" (Matthew 19:16-19). There was doubt in him, but the Master did not do other than remind him obedience to the laws of God, he marked the lines within which to obtain eternal life.

In us there should not be any doubt, we should not be swayed away but on the contrary, we should withstand the tests that we will have in our daily lives. God promises us a crown of righteousness that he will give us in that day, but as the apostle Paul says: "If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard" (Colossians 1:23).

Remember that Saul, due to his disobedience towards God, fell from the grace of God. Let us not fall into such error.
