Biblical Reading: **1 Thessalonians 4:1-8**

Memorization Text: **Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: for I the LORD your God am holy.**
(Leviticus 19:2 KJV)

COMMENTARY

The terms holy and holiness signify to be kept apart and separation, but, separation from what? From sin 1 John 3:4. God makes the people of Israel to take notice that if they keep the law and keep his pact, they will be his people of priests (Exodus 19:5-6). We shall not disobey our God, we must walk according to what is holy, that in our hearts our walk shall live (Isaiah 35:8). Let us move away from rancor, ire, gluttony, drunkenness, tattoos, etc; there is a need to crucify our joys of the flesh (Galatians 5:19-21) says the Apostle Paul "Also we have a cloud of witnesses that observe our behavior" If we do away with the joys of the flesh God allows us to have an incorruptible crown and joyfully we will be able to say "I have fought a good fight, I have finished the course" 2 Timothy 4:7-8.
