## COMMENTARY

These words "Honor your father and your mother" were given approximately 3,500 years ago by a father in the Mount Sinai, to separate and define the authority and the functions of each member in a family.

Today, let us remember this commandment, because sometimes it is forgotten in us that all that were born and have lived since Cain and Abel we have been born of a father and a mother and for many sons and daughters this commandment seems to be very ancient and common, Prov. 20:29 reminds us of a family rule.
