COMMENTARY

How do we behave outside the Temple? We could ask what question is this, as of course, a child of God that we see in the temple is the same outside. But, is this reality?

Outside, we are among people, and it might be that we are “well behaved”, but it can happen that we are one person inside and another outside, and that we are not necessarily “white doves”

This shows that we do not have something very important, essential for our walking and arrival at the award that God has offered. We require that ingredient to be the same person in and out of temple.

Even, we could say that our behavior is “the same”, but really, it might be that we fall short.

Let us study this important lesson.
