## COMMENTARY

---

An ark was utilized in the times of Noah, and that ark had no problems navigating through the waters of the flood, had no problems at all, it found throughout its voyage, no icebergs, no rock formations, nor anything that would stop it or would make it sink, thus it sailed until it got to a safe place among the mountains of Ararat, saving all passengers in the ark, both men and animals. Today in the 21st century those of us who want to be saved, we do not fight against the literal waters as Noah and his family did, but against the waters (doctrines) of the religions that do not obey the Eternal Father but obey commandments and teachings of the preachers of the world. Today those are more numerous which go against those who keep the commandments of God and that have the testimony of Jesus Christ (Rev. 12:147): the waves, the winds, the worldly desires that it seems that our boat sinks in the furious seas.
