COMMENTARY

These men of God lived through special events, the same as Peter, the Lord allowed them to be the only witnesses among his disciples, they were present in the resurrection of the daughter of Jairus, Mark 5:37 in the transfiguration he took them Matthew 17:1 when the Master was anguished at Gethsemani, as the hour was coming Mark 14:32-33 also when the Samaritans did not receive Him, they asked him for something Luke 9:54.

The sons of Zebedee were participants of these and more moments with the Master. They apparently were Galileans, thrusting, lively, of disciplined and sometimes misplaced jealousy. But with a perseverent faith of following the Son of God, in any circumstance even to the cost of their lives.
